Description

The art of acting is based on everyday life principles. Students will learn how to take the techniques learned in this class and apply them to their other courses and major, as well as personal growth. Intro to Drama is an introduction to the elements of performance. This is primarily a lab class. Requirements include class attendance and participation, small performance and/or written assignments, reading assignments, play attendance with a written critique, practicum hours on the KELT production and a final scene performance.
