Description

Provided with general guidelines, students will be involved in case studies and projects in area of their specialization. This course will give the opportunity to apply and polish the knowledge received in previous two courses. The course is aimed at the development of students' leadership competencies and the application of their theoretical knowledge, received in previous two courses, in practice through resolving real business cases for partner companies.
