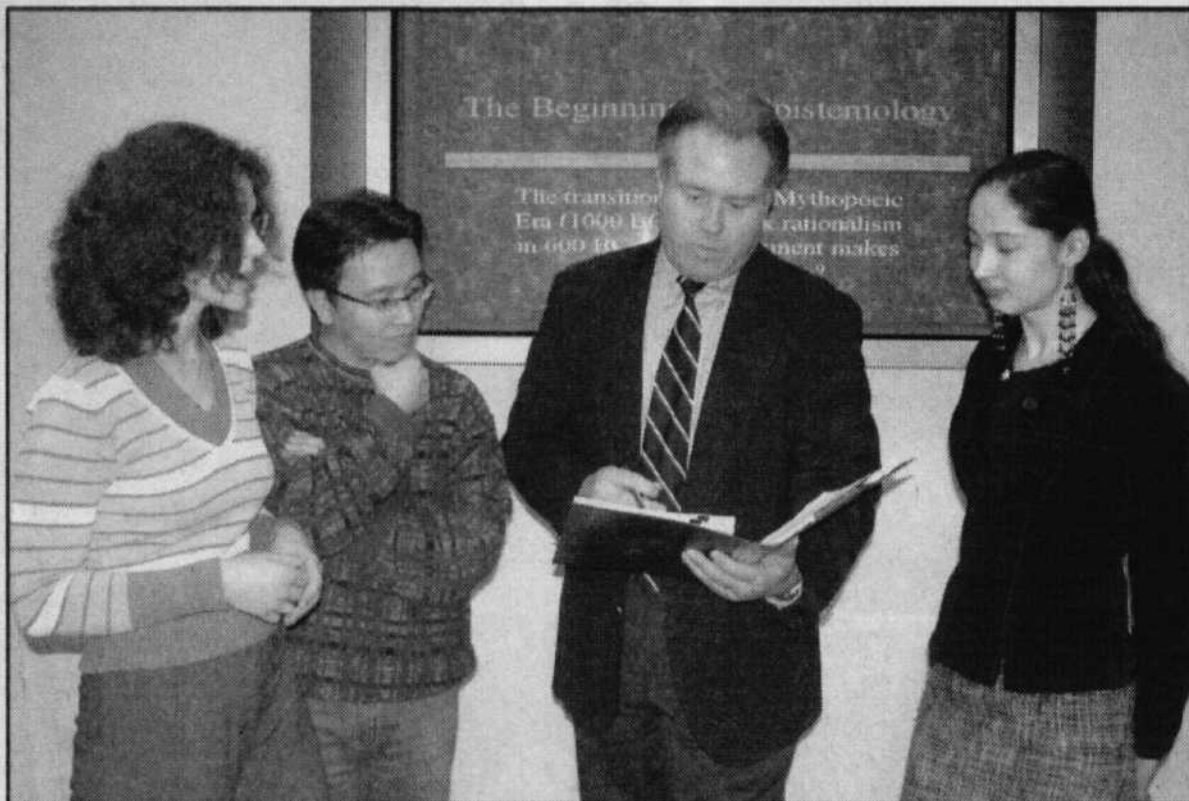
The Apex of Educational Achievement in Business Education

Period of Study

The DBA is structured in line with the North American model. It comprises roughly two years of coursework (45 credits), two years of research and a dissertation (12 credits). Students can major in Management, Marketing, Accounting, Finance, and Information Systems; and Operations Management.
